

Raymond Gram Swing Repeats Book-Burning Charges Tonight

Raymond Gram Swing, Blue network news analyst, will repeat a broadcast of 10 years ago on his newscast at 10:15 tonight over WIBA.

Shocked and repelled by the announcement of the burning of books in Germany on May 10, 1933, Swing devoted his broadcast to an indictment of the act, and the Council on Books in Wartime and the Office of War Information asked him to revive it.
