\$15,000 ASKED IN DEATH SUIT

Suit Is Outgrowth Of Highway Mishap

Asking \$15,000 damages for the life of his son, Lewis Wheeler, administrator of the child's estate, Friday filed suit in the Allen-co common pleas court against Ned R. Campbell.

The child, Lewis Wheeler, Jr., was killed Dec. 12, 1943, when struck on the Elm-st road by an automobile driven by Campbell, according to the petition. The father charges that his son's death was caused by the "negligence and carelessness" of Campbell.
