

'Case of Beautiful Brunette' Will Provide Radio Mystery

A soldier who sacrificed his life in France to save his buddy, a man who walks in to a telegraph office and without reason shoots the girl behind the counter, and a trip that "Nick Carter, Master Detective," makes to the Red Rose dance hall, form the background for "The Case of the Beautiful Brunette," to be heard at 7 p. m. over MBS.
