

'The Affairs of Susan' Stars Joan Fontaine in Screen Role

Joan Fontaine makes her second "Hollywood Players" appearance on Tuesday, over CBS at 9:30 p. m., to star in "The Affairs of Susan," adapted from her own recent hit picture. Fans of the beautiful blonde Academy Award winner—who made her first "Hollywood Players" appearance in her prize-winning picture, "Rebecca"—will hear Miss Fontaine as several distinct types: a fresh, unspoiled young girl, an actress who is trying to be artificial and sophisticated, an intellectual type and a poised and charming young woman, as she "tries on" various personalities in the hope of winning back her divorced husband.
